Job Description

Serving in the Interpretive Department, the Nature and Heritage Interpreter will pursue a wide array of duties including leading public tours of our museum and lighthouse, designing and delivering educational programs to schools and youth groups, greeting visitors, answering public inquiries, leading special event-day activities, and generally assisting with our day-to-day operations. They will also pursue an independent project, based on their interests and the needs of Cape Jourimain, which will be designed in collaboration with the Education Manager.

Staff will have the opportunity to participate in special events at the centre, including our 2019 speaker series on climate change, a festival of historic arts and crafts, and the 150th celebration of our on-site lighthouse.

Qualifications

The ideal candidate will be energetic, positive, and resourceful, with a desire to learn. Applicants must be comfortable with public speaking and working in a team environment. The ability to effectively communicate in both English and French is considered an asset.

An individual pursuing a degree, or with a significant level of interest, in history, environmental science, or education, would be preferred.

Prior work experience in customer service, youth education, or in a museum would be beneficial. Certification in First Aid and possession of a valid Class-5 Driver's License would be considered an asset.
